JV – Open Races: Each school may run an unlimited number of runners, all of who qualify for the individual awards. Team scoring will be tabulated using a runner’s actual finish. All Team awards will be given out at the awards ceremony at 7:45 p.m. following the Varsity Races. **Note:** The Individual awards for the JV – Open Race will be given out at the finish line in the chute area after the completion of the race.

Varsity Boys/Girls Races: Each school may run seven participants with five counting in the scoring. All runners place of finish will be used in determining final team scores. Ties will be broken by the place of the team’s sixth runner. All Individual and Team awards will be given out at the awards ceremony at 7:45 p.m.
